COMING SOON TO KIDS TOGETHER PLAYGROUND

For years, we have wondered whether a **wheelchair-accessible swing** would be a good fit for KTP, so we were excited when we found the We Go Swing. It's wheelchair-accessible, but much more! The We Go Swing has two bays – one for a wheelchair and another with a bench – so everyone can share the fun! When we showed the idea to the Town of Cary and offered to help pay for it, everything fell into place. We're thrilled to announce that the We Go Swing is scheduled for installation by December 1!



The Town of Cary does an incredible job of keeping KTP safe and up to date. When our 23-year-old playhouses began to show their age, the town stepped up to replace them, inviting Kids Together to help select the new ones. We're happy to tell you that **two new preschool area playhouses** will be installed at the same time as the We Go Swing – hooray!

Some areas of the playground will be closed the week of November 27, as the new swing and playhouses are installed. We are grateful to the Town of Cary for their commitment to the playground. And we're proud to contribute to new playground features, thanks to the funds we raise each year at our Walk, Run & Roll for Inclusive Play.
