But that's not all. Kids Together has many features that are accessible and inclusive: the raised sand table, the Sway Fun, and the Oracle talk-tube benches, to name a few.

In early 1999, the lot selected for the playground was cleared, with diggers moving dirt, and lots of it! Tons of infill were needed to position the playground above the flood plain. It would take almost a year and a half for the playground to be ready for play. It seemed to take forever, but it was certainly worth waiting for!







GROWNUPS - THE KT BOARD NEEDS YOU!

Do you ever wonder who puts together the fun activities at KTP? Who identifies new equipment for the playground? Who monitors conditions on the playground? Who leads the fundraising efforts?

The answer to all these is the same – the Kids Together Board of Directors! Kids Together is an all-volunteer organization. What we seek in our board members is a commitment to actively participate, a respect for individuals with disabilities, and a passion for outdoor play.

Our board meets every two months for about an hour-and-a-half, in person at the Cary Arts Center or virtually. Besides attending the meetings, board members help plan and volunteer for events at the playground. They are expected to make an annual membership donation (\$30 minimum) and assist with member recruitment and other fundraising efforts. Prospective board members are required to complete and pass a background screening. The cost of the screening is covered by the organization.
